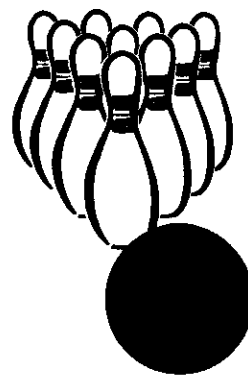


9 PIN NO-TAP JUNIOR/ADULT TOURNAMENT



New City Bowl will be hosting a No-Tap Junior/Adult Tournament!

PRIZES

1 in 5 entries will receive a prize. All prizes will be awarded in the form of gift certificates.

Entry Fee is \$40 per team—\$26 prizes/\$14 lineage/\$0 expenses.

Teams must consist of one Junior and one Adult bowler.

Handicap is 90% of 440 team.

All bowlers must have a valid USBC sanctioned average from the '09-'10 or '08-'09 bowling season or use 220 average.

Squad

Entries close the day before each squad, walk-ins permitted if space is available—must register 1/2 hour before squad start time.

Tournament Rules

1. The tournament is a USBC certified, No-Tap Doubles tournament, and will follow all USBC rules. Each team must consist of one junior and one adult bowler.
2. The tournament will have 4 squads on July 23rd – July 25th. There is limited availability for the squad on July 23rd – entries are accepted on a first come/first served basis. Re-entries are allowed, however each team can only receive one prize. Re-entries with different partners can receive any prizes they qualify for.
3. This is a Handicap Tournament: 90% of the difference between the bowlers combined averages and 440.
4. The entry fee for this tournament will be \$40.00 per team, consisting of \$14.00 for lineage, \$26.00 for prize fund, \$0 for expenses. Entries must be accompanied by payment in full.
5. Prize fund to be returned 100% to the participants, in the form of gift certificates. There will be a prize ratio of at least 1 prize for every 5 entries.
6. Walk-ins permitted up to ½ hour before start time if lanes are available.
7. No entry fees will be returned.
8. Entering Averages: Bowlers will use their highest '09-'10 USBC sanctioned average of 21 games or more. If an entrant does not have a '09-'10 average, their average will be based on the following: (1) highest '08-'09 USBC sanctioned winter average of 21 games or more, (2) highest '08-'09 USBC sanctioned summer average of 21 games or more, (3) 220 average. Rule 319.a-2 is waived. All averages will be checked, average corrections must be made within 48 hours after completion of bowling – see USBC Rule 319.a-3.
9. Bowlers will bowl 3 games on one pair of lanes. Games will be scored in a 9 pin no-tap format (9 pins on your first ball counts as a strike, all other scoring is the same as regulation play).
10. Substitutes: All substitutes must be reported to the tournament official at least ½ hour before scheduled bowling.
11. Any bowler who arrives after a game has started will be permitted to bowl; he/she will receive a 0 count for frames missed.
12. There will be no re-racking permitted without authorization of the tournament committee.
13. Any protest affecting eligibility, playing rules, or errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament secretary within 24 hours. The Tournament Committee shall decide any questions not covered by these tournament rules.
14. In case of a tie for the championship, a one-game roll-off will be conducted.
15. We will conduct a draw for lane assignments.
