## **Tournament Rules**

1. The tournament will have 1 squad.
2. This is a Scratch Tournament.
3. Bowlers will bowl on the specified PBA Experience Pattern.
4. The entry fee for this tournament will be \$30.00 per person, consisting of \$7.00 for lineage, \$23.00 for prize fund, \$0 for expenses. New City Bowl Summer League bowlers will pay \$25.00 with \$18.00 going to the prize fund.
5. Entries must be accompanied by payment in full.
6. Prize fund to be returned 100% to the participants, in the form of cash for adult bowlers, scholarships for junior bowlers (managed by the SMART Scholarship program). All junior bowlers must sign a USBC prize waiver. There will be a prize ratio of at least 1 prize for every 6 entries.
7. Walk-ins permitted up to ½ hour before start time if lanes are available.
8. No entry fees will be returned.
9. Bowlers will bowl 4 games, rotating one pair to the right after each game. The last pair of lanes will move to the first pair. The top bowlers will face off in a stepladder finals match.
10. Bowlers need not hold a sport bowling sanction to participate in the tournament.
11. All substitutes must be reported to the tournament official at least ½ hour before scheduled bowling.
12. Any bowler who arrives after a game has started will be permitted to bowl; he/she will receive a 0 count for frames missed.
13. There will be no re-racking permitted without authorization of the tournament committee.
14. Any protest affecting eligibility, playing rules, or errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament secretary within 24 hours.
15. The Tournament Committee shall decide any questions not covered by these tournament rules.
16. In case of a tie for the championship, a one-game roll-off will be conducted.
17. We will conduct a draw for lane assignments.
